However, we have not managed to get this on the warranty and the cost of the renovation therefore ends up on the association.

To keep costs down, the board has decided to remove the wooden deck by ourselves. This work will start already during the week starting on October 24th, but with main focus on the weekend of October 29th and 30th, when most members of the board are available.

As the deck is quite large, the board would really appreciate some reinforcement to the work effort during this weekend. If you have an hour or so to spare, please come by and help the board to tear down some planks. We offer coffee and good company.

Briefly about the ventilation measures

As surely no one has escaped, ventilation measures have now been carried out in both houses during the past two weeks. All apartments have been visited and <u>no return visits</u> have been necessary. Both the board and VentExpert would like to thank you very much for a very good collaboration!

The work has progressed very well and both cleaning and adjustment of the air flows have now been done. Some valves were found to be very dirty. The board will come back with a short instruction on how we can easily maintain and clean our valves in the kitchen and bathroom ourselves. For instance, it is important that we do not spin the "plate" that sits on these two valves ourselves, as this affects the air flows.

We are now awaiting the report from VentExpert and information on whether future maintenance plans should be adjusted or not.

The board now hopes for better air flows and will also continue to monitor and work actively to get more control over the temperatures in the apartments.

Status of the case regarding condensation problems

As the board previously announced, we have started a process against Einar Mattsson, the contractor, regarding the recurring problems with condensation in some of our apartments. Correspondence between lawyers is currently ongoing, but no solution is reach just yet.

However, the board considers that we have a strong case and hopes that we can resolve the conflict in the near future.
